

NOTICE OF CITY OF SUWANEЕ
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 21-2-1 et seq. and all other applicable Georgia laws, please be advised that on November 7, 2017, a general municipal election will be held in the City of Suwanee, Georgia, at which time there will be submitted to the qualified voters of said City for their determination the expired term of: Council Member, Post 3 (to succeed Linnea Miller; Council Member, Post 4 (to succeed Beth Hilscher); and Council Member, Post 5 (to succeed Dan Foster).

The election shall be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2017, between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 7:00 o'clock p.m. at Suwanee City Hall, 330 Town Center Avenue, Suwanee, Georgia. All duly qualified electors of the City of Suwanee are urged to participate. Those qualified to vote at said election shall be determined in all respects in accordance and in conformity with the laws of the State of Georgia.

Those interested in qualifying for said offices should be advised that the respective qualification period shall run from Monday, August 21, 2017 at 8:30 a.m. through Wednesday, August 23, 2017 at 4:30 p.m. at Suwanee City Hall. Qualification will close at 4:30 p.m., on Wednesday, August 23, 2017. Individuals intending to qualify shall remit the sum of \$270.00.

The registration deadline to vote in this election shall close at 4:30 p.m., October 10, 2017. Any person who is presently registered as a voter in said City but who now resides outside the City limits is not eligible to vote in said election. All duly qualified electors of the City of Suwanee, Georgia, are urged to participate. Those qualified to vote at said election shall be determined in all respects in accordance and in conformity with the laws of the State of Georgia. Information on voter registration may be obtained through the Chief Registrar of Gwinnett County, Georgia.

In accordance with the City Charter, the successful candidate(s) will be determined by majority of votes. A run-off election, if necessary, shall be held December 5, 2017.

This and all City of Suwanee Elections are governed by the Municipal Election Code of the State of Georgia and the City Charter. A copy of the ordinance and/or resolution calling for the election is on file, together with other relevant documents, for inspection at the City Clerk's Office, 330 Town Center Avenue, Suwanee, Georgia 30024, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday.
