

A Special Note for Boot Camps and Recreation Organizations regarding the use of City Parks and Trails

There is nothing better than seeing people truly enjoy the parks, trails and amenities that have helped make Suwanee an award-winning community. We're glad that people are enjoying the amenities and that you are encouraging them to lead a healthy lifestyle.

Because of the popularity of Suwanee's parks, especially Town Center Park, with boot camps and fitness organizations, we request your assistance in protecting our parks and ensuring that everyone has access to the parks. We request your cooperation in the following guidelines listed below so that, boot camps and other recreation/fitness organizations can be better managed, enhancing the enjoyment for all who use the parks and trail system. With your cooperation, we hope that it will not become necessary to prohibit the use of the parks and trail system from any sort of recreation or fitness organizations.

- Camps/classes taught by anyone doing business within City of Suwanee City limits who charge a fee for participation should obtain a Suwanee business License/occupational tax certificate. See Business Matters/Business Licenses page at www.suwanee.com.
- No area of the park may be blocked off or restricted to others at any time.
- Resistance bands should not be used on benches, poles, trees or other structures in the park.
- No amplified sound is permitted in any city park without a permit.
- Whistles and noise level should remain at a minimum level so as not to disrupt normal use of the park or trail or surrounding residents or businesses.
- For classes held before sunrise, no whistles are permitted. Residents live around the park and should not be disturbed before daybreak or a more reasonable hour on weekends.
- Please clean up after your group. Trash cans are located throughout the park and trail.
- Please follow all park and trail rules.
- Please avoid hosting multiple classes at the same location multiple times in the same day/week. These classes can cause a tremendous amount of wear and tear to the park and trail system.
- Please avoid high traffic areas or damaged grounds.
- No financial transactions of any kind may take place in any city park, trail or parking lot.
- No tables, banners, signs, advertising or promotion of any kind for any business is permitted at any time in any park.
- At times, maintenance may be necessary to the trails or grounds. When possible, the city tries to post notice of maintenance on the city website at www.suwanee.com.
