Contents of the email should include that gardeners need to tend to their plot and will give them three days before placing a yellow garden stake at the plot.
  - Yellow Stake is placed 3 days after Warning Email sent
  - Red Stake is placed 7-10 days after Yellow Stake is placed and warning email is sent
  - Policy for Garden of the Month
  - Vice Chair typically selects the Garden of the Month at first of the month or after monthly meeting.
