COUNCIL WORKSHOP

- **A. Staff Updates** The following items are not planned for discussion at the workshop, unless specifically requested by Council.
 - I. Alcohol Beverage License Courtyard Marriott

 Courtyard Marriott, located at 310 Celebration Drive, has applied for a new licensee to serve beer, wine and distilled spirits. Mr. Rajendra Patel is the licensee. The Business Services department recommends approval.
 - 2. Surplus Sale

Staff has scheduled a surplus sale for early May. Approval of the itemized list will be included on the <u>March 27 consent agenda</u>, unless Council prefers otherwise.

3. Sawmill Drive Median Closure

Georgia DOT's contractor, Baldwin Paving Company, Inc., is underway with construction activities.

4. Arbor Day Proclamation

Staff will prepare and forward the annual Arbor Day proclamation for the <u>March 27 regular agenda</u>, unless Council prefers otherwise.

B. CIP Updates

I. PIB Medians

Staff has released a bid for modifications to the Peachtree Industrial Blvd. medians. Bids are due March 19. Staff anticipates being able to recommend a contractor by the <u>March 27 regular agenda</u>.

2. Georgia DOT Indemnification Agreement

As part of the Solis Town Center Project, Terwilliger Pappas installed a water quality device in the Buford Highway right-of-way. The state has asked the City to sign an indemnification agreement with GDOT. Approval of this agreement will be included on the <u>March 27 consent agenda</u>, unless Council prefers otherwise.

3. Town Center on Main

C. RZ-2017-009 – Owner: Karen Williams. Applicant: Jennifer Spencer. The applicant requests a rezoning from R-100 (Residential Single Family District) to OTCD (Old Town Commercial District) to allow for a reception hall. The site is located along White Street across from White Street Park and contains approximately 1.5 acres.

The Planning Department recommends approval with conditions. There is no recommendation from the Planning Commission.

D. Right-of-Way Agreements

The City's Right of Way ordinance requires a service agreement between utilities and the City prior to issuance of any Right of Way permits. Verizon and ATT Mobility are seeking service agreements that would allow for the installation of small cells in the right of way. The proposed agreements were negotiated by the Georgia Municipal Association on behalf of the City. Consideration of the agreements will be included on the <u>March 27 regular agenda</u>, unless Council prefers otherwise.

E. Short Term Work Program

Staff will present the draft STWP, that was developed at the City Council retreat. Adoption of the STWP will be included on the March 27 consent agenda, unless Council prefers otherwise.
