COUNCIL WORKSHOP

A. Municipal Court Report

B. North Gwinnett Arts Association Report

A North Gwinnett Arts Association (NGAA) representative will give an update on the arts center and discuss future plans, organizational structure, and financial status. The agreement is up for renewal July, 2018.

C. Staff Updates - The following items are not planned for discussion at the workshop, unless specifically requested by Council.

I. Satellite Blvd. Intersection Modifications

Phase two of the Sawmill Drive median closure project includes improvements to the intersection of Lawrenceville-Suwanee Road and Satellite Blvd. including the installation of dual left turn lanes. Gwinnett DOT and GaDOT are working in conjunction with the contractor who is repaving Lawrenceville-Suwanee Road to complete all of these projects together.

2. Lawrenceville-Suwanee Road Resurfacing

GaDOT's contractor is underway with the milling and resurfacing work on Lawrenceville-Suwanee Road. Weather permitting, this project is tentatively scheduled for completion by July 31.

3. PIB Landscaping Project

After some rain delays, BrightView Landscaping Company is underway with the landscape modification project for the PIB medians.
