A. Police Quarterly Report

- **B. Staff Updates** The following items are not planned for discussion at the workshop, unless specifically requested by Council.
 - I. Alcohol Beverage License Dash Fin dba Sushi Nama Suwanee Dash Fin dba Sushi Nami Suwanee, located at 4369 Suwanee Dam Road, has applied for a new license to serve beer, wine, and distilled spirits. Mr. Scott Jeon is the licensee. The Business Services department recommends approval. Consideration of this item will be included on the October 24 regular agenda.
 - 2. City Hall Roof Repairs

Due to ongoing water leaks of the City Hall roof and window front curtain, a consultant has studied and prepared a report with recommended repairs. Bids for this work are

due on October 16. Staff anticipates recommending a contract for consideration on the October 24 regular agenda.

3. Municipal Court Fee Revisions

- D. RZ 2017-008 Owner: Halifax Enterprises, LLC. Applicant: Corridor Development, Inc. The applicant requests a rezoning from C-2 (General Commercial) to RM-8 (Residential Multi-Family Duplex District) to allow for townhomes. The site is located in Land Lot 237 of the 7th District at 760 Peachtree Industrial Boulevard and contains approximately 6.1 acres.
