I. Consider Abandoning White Lane Right-of-Way

The existing right-of-way on White Lane is proposed to be abandoned in association with the recently approved development.

Consider Approving Resolution to Refinance the Parks & Open Space Bonds It appears there is an opportunity to refinance the City's series 2006 General Obligation bonds used for parks and open space with an outstanding balance of approximately \$12.2 million. In order to proceed, the Council must adopt a Parameter's Resolution.
- K. Consider Award of Contract to Amaysing Services, Inc. in an Amount Not to Exceed \$61,960.00 to Construct a Pier at Sims Lake Park

The City has received bids to construct a covered pier on the lake at Sims Lake Park. Staff recommends awarding this contract to Amaysing Services, Inc. of Gainesville. This was one of the projects identified in the City's 2010 Park Enhancements study.
