I. White Street Park, Phase 2

The construction drawings have been approved by the City and a bid package is being finalized. Staff anticipates this contract will be ready for consideration at the October Council meeting.

2. Settles Bridge Road Drainage Improvement

As of September 6, 2016, the 4520 & 4530 Settles Bridge Road drainage improvement project construction was underway and approximately 70% complete. This contract was awarded to J. Heard Inc., of Stone Mountain in the amount of \$70,595 and is funded by SPLOST. Construction activities consist of installation of three storm drain inlets and storm drainage piping.

D. RZ 2016-004 - Owner: Donald Johnsa. Applicant: Lynwood Development. The applicant requests a rezoning from M-I (Light Industry District) and

R-140 (Residential Single Family District) to PMUD (Planned Mixed-Use Development) to allow for a mixed-use development. The site is located in Land Lot 236 of the 7th District at 450 Buford Highway and contains approximately 18.0 acres.

This item was postponed last month.
