- II. Consider Request for On-Street Parking Regulations in Village Grove

c. Approve Contract for Funding with Georgia DOT for the Brushy Creek Trail Project

Preliminary Engineering for the Brushy Creek Trail is complete. The next step in the process is to enter into a contract for funding with the Georgia Department of Transportation. The funding status for the project has not changed, but completing this step will move the project one step closer to being "shovel ready."
