- I. Consider Transmittal of Downtown Suwanee Master Plan to Atlanta Regional Commission
- J. Consider Application for ARC Public Art Grant Program

The Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) has announced a new public art program which, through a grant process, will provide matching funds to help communities install public art. Staff proposes submitting an application that centers on the "LIVES" piece of steel from the demolished Gwinnett County water tower that the City possesses. The application deadline is August 3, 2015 and must include confirmation of the matching funds. Staff requests that the City provide a \$15,000 match.

K. Consider a Resolution to Transfer Certain Property to the City's Downtown Development Authority

The City owns approximately 3 acres along Buford Highway adjacent to Chicago Street. The resolution would transfer the property to the DDA for their use and/or disposal.

L. Authorize the Mayor to Enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Suwanee Development Authority Pertaining to Certain Property Transferred to the Downtown Development Authority

This IGA establishes certain conditions and procedures pertaining to how the DDA must dispose of certain land transferred to them in the item above.

M. Consider Authorizing the Mayor to Enter Into an Amended Memorandum of Agreement with Georgia Department of Transportation Related to the TE Grant for the Brushy Creek Greenway Project

Georgia DOT recently requested the City to amend a Memorandum of Understanding. Council authorized the Mayor to enter into the MOU with the GDOT earlier this year. They are now wanting to revise it.
