The City of Suwanee is initiating a rezoning from M-I (Light Industry District) and PMUD (Planned Mixed Use Development District) to PMUD with conditions to allow for mixed-use development including multi-family and commercial uses. The tracts are located in Land Lot 236 of the 7th District on the southeast corner of Buford Highway and Chicago Street.

b. 2015 Millage Rate

We have received our 2015 tax consolidation information from Gwinnett County. After

analyzing the data provided from Gwinnett County, staff recommends a proposed millage rate of 4.93 mills, the same proposed millage rate used in the adopted FY 2016 budget and the same millage rate as the past three years. In accordance with state law, three public hearings have been scheduled on the proposed millage rate. This is the third of three total hearings.
