The City must enter into an agreement with Georgia DOT in order to proceed with the needed right-of-way acquisition for the Buford Highway reconstruction project.

N. Consider Award of Contract to Peach State Construction Company for Brushy Creek Greenway, Phase I

The City has received bids for construction of the Brushy Creek Greenway, Phase I. Staff has reviewed the bids and recommends awarding to Peach State Construction Company in an amount not to exceed \$595,222.

O. Award Contract to Allied Paving Contractors, Inc. in the Amount of \$828,208.35

The City has released bid packages for the LMIG resurfacing project, to include resurfacing of approximately 3.4 miles of City streets, as well as additional parking at Sims Lake Park. The City received three bids on this project and Allied Paving Contractors, Inc., of Pendergrass, GA, was the low bidder.
