As part of the 2013 budget, the City will be purchasing new financial software. The City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for this purchase and received six proposals. After review, demonstrations, and site visits, staff recommends awarding this contract to BS&A Software for an estimated amount of \$182,645.

I. Authorize Mayor to Enter into an Agreement with Gwinnett County for McGinnis Ferry Rd. and PIB Intersection Improvements

The City and County have negotiated an agreement for the County to upgrade the pedestrian access facilitites at the intersection of McGinnis Ferry Road and Peachtree Industrial Blvd. The City must commit funding for 50% of the design and construction costs, not to exceed \$75,000. As this project was not planned in the CIP, no dedicated funding is currently identified. Staff recommends using the Facilities Enhancement Fund for this expenditure.

2. Accept Irrigation Water Line Easement from Precision Design & Development Company, Inc.

In order to construct the Town Center Park irrigation well, a water line easement is needed along portions of the alley behind the residences on Portland Trail Drive and Suwanee Avenue. The easement is six feet in width with a 10-foot temporary construction easement.
