J. Consider Authorizing Gwinnett County to Install an Upgraded Traffic Signal at McGinnis Ferry Road and Scales Road

The City is coordinating with Gwinnett County to install a traffic signal at McGinnis Ferry Road and Scales Road. The County's standard installation includes concrete poles with wires spanning the intersection. In the past, the City has paid to upgrade such signal installations to include mast arms and underground utilities. The County has estimated a cost not to exceed \$25,000 for this upgrade.
