**B. Staff Updates Agenda:** The following items are not planned for discussion at the workshop, unless specifically requested by Council.

### I. 2013 Election

Qualifying for the 2013 Municipal Election concluded on August 28 with one candidate qualifying for each post. In accordance with O.C.G.A. §21-2-291, staff has prepared a draft ordinance/resolution to certify the results and authorize cancellation of the election. Approval of this ordinance/resolution will be included on the September  $24^{th}$  consent agenda, unless Council prefers otherwise.

2. Alcohol Beverage License: Anatolia Café & Hookah Lounge

This business has applied for a license for on-premise consumption of beer, wine, and distilled spirits for 2855 Lawrenceville Suwanee Road, Suite 800. Mr. Thomas Hails is the applicant. The Finance department has reviewed the application and recommends approval. Consideration of this item will be included on the September 24<sup>th</sup> public hearing and regular agenda, unless Council prefers otherwise.

3. Hotel May Queen Demolition

The project is now substantially complete. Grass was recently planted, which will establish soon.



4. Doors to Homes and Hope Exhibit

Habitat for Humanity and ArtWorks! Gwinnett have partnered to bring a Countywide awareness and fundraising initiative for the two groups. Artists have created 140 hand-paointed doors, which will be displayed in an outdoor art exhibit around Gwinnett communities (primarily in Suwanee, Duluth, and Norcorss). The doors will be will be displayed during the month of October and then sold in an online auction, with proceeds benefitting the two groups. The majority of the doors in Suwanee will be displayed in Sims Lake Park, with some in Town Center. Suwanee will host a media event on Monday, October 7<sup>th</sup> to conincide with "World Habitat Day."

C. SUP 2013-003— The applicant requests a special use permit to allow for a veterinary clinic with boarding in the M-I Zoning District. The site is located on Buford Highway at the driveway for George Pierce Park. Staff recommends approval with conditions.
