N. Consider Authorizing the Mayor to Execute a Contract with URS Corporation for Professional Design and Construction Administration Services for the Buford Highway Reconstruction Project

The City received five responses to the RFQ for professional design and construction administration services. A committee reviewed the proposals and interviewed two teams of consultants on December 3. The selection committee recommends awarding this contract to URS Corporation of Atlanta.

O. Consider Adopting Ordinance to Permit Home Brew Special Events

During this past legislative session, the state legislature passed HB 99 which permits home-brew special events upon adoption of local legislation. A model local ordinance has been drafted and reviewed by Legislative Counsel and the state Department of Revenue.

P. Consider Authorizing the Mayor to Approve Change Order #1 in the Amount of \$20,465.50 with Astra Companies for the Buford Highway Sidewalk Construction Project

This project consists of the construction of a 5' wide sidewalk from the entrance to George Pierce Park north along the east side of Buford Highway to North Dollar Circle (connecting to the existing sidewalk in front of Park Pointe) and then north to connect to the existing sidewalk on Ruby Forest Parkway. The change order addresses some needed design and construction modifications due to site conditions.
