1. Call to Order - Sara Kleinfeld called the meeting to order at 5:00 pm. Travis Lanier, David Sullivan, Dan Foster, Roger Grant and Heather Rattledge were present; visiting was Richard Trice.
2. Adoption of Agenda - Dan made the motion which was seconded by David to adopt the agenda as presented. The motion passed 6-0.
3. Approval of July Minutes - There was a motion by Travis which was seconded by David. The motion passed 6-0.
4. Work Program - The previous work program was reviewed.
5. Butterfly Garden - Travis has met with the Girl Scouts and they will be thinning out plants, adding pine straw, and redoing the signage.
They also have a U.S. flag pallet project and they will be giving us 2 for the garden.
6. Phase 2 of Garden - We will review the previous plan at the next meeting; there is possibly a septic drain field underneath which will limit what we do.
7. Sculpture Update - The Mother and Child sculpture will be donated to the garden and installed by public works.
8. Budget - The garden account has \$41,045.00 and there is nothing else to note.

10. Committee Reports - updates for all committees:
Social - We will cancel the previously planned lemonade social for October due to lack of interest for planning; The "farm to table" event will be held at Dan's clubhouse (he will reserve) and the date will be changed to 10/17.
Projects - The garden is in need of new sprayers and Dan will proceed with this purchase.
The composting area for the garden will be discussed at the next meeting; we will need signage for composting instructions.
Dan will purchase big brown bags for weeds and waste at the garden.
Orchard - There are plans to add a fort to the top of the earth mound play area; this will be presented to the city council at the August meeting.
11. Other -
~Richard Trice with The Suwanee Business Alliance announced that at Suwanee Days, September 19th-20th, the group will have a booth with a putting green and any monies made from the putts will be given to the garden.
