- 1. Call to Order Called to order at 5:04pm; in attendance Richard Trice, David Sullivan, Travis Lanier, Dan Foster, Roger Grant, Heather Ratledge and Jessica Roth.
- 2. Adoption of Agenda Roger moved to adopt the agenda and David seconded.
- 3. Approval of October Minutes -David moved to approve the minutes and Heather seconded.
- 4. Open Board seats Heather's and Sara's Travis will send out an email to recruit interested parties.
- 5. Butterfly garden Girl Scouts want to wrap up the project by the end of November; funding for nametags was not obtained by the scouts; 11x17 signs are \$38 (we need 4) voted on and approved; scouts name tags will be in B&W.
- 6. Budget 16 small plots are still available, but we are way ahead from last year this time; we have received \$225 in donations.
- 7. Volunteer hours 5 food cans donated will equal 1 hour; bucket will be in the city hall lobby. November's workday was very light; we will look into a text reminder service.
- 8. Work program Completion was bumped to the December meeting due to time constraints.
- 9. Committee Reports:

Maintenance – Hoses will be removed for the winter and stone needs to be spread in early spring – we will look into help from the scouts or consider court community service. Items have been stolen from the garden tool shed – we will need to change lock code in spring and evaluate the tool inventory. Also, the cistern is blocked again – the PVC at the bottom will need to be drained and replaced.

- 10. Phase 2 of the garden We have 70 ft. from garden lower sidewalk to the septic lines; certainly enough room for a 10×20 greenhouse and some community beds as well.
- 11. Other The major complaint of those leaving the garden this year was pests; it was suggested that we treat the entire garden for pests at one time. Roger and Travis will look into this.
