If your taxes are paid from an escrow account through your mortgage lender, please forward a copy of your 2018 tax bill to your lender to ensure prompt payment.




Where do your taxes go?

The City provides a wide range of municipal services to citizens including police protection, parks and recreation, planning and zoning, building inspections, code enforcement, economic and community development, special events, municipal court services, and infrastructure maintenance.

In 2018, the average home value in Suwanee is \$300,000 and the typical resident will pay about \$590 in property taxes.
