A. Partnership Gwinnett Annual Update

- C. Staff Updates
 - I. Public Works Building Project

Staff is presently underway with finalizing quantities and layout of pallet racks and storage areas for the Swiftwater Park Drive Public Works Facility. Staff recommends awarding this contract, contingent on satisfactory completion of contract negotiations, to Crown Lift Trucks

in an amount not to exceed \$64,000. Staff anticipates the contract will be ready for award (based upon final configuration) on the <u>January 22, 2019 regular agenda</u>, unless Council prefers otherwise.

2. Stormwater Project on Grand Vista Approach and Chattahoochee Run Drive

Staff recommends awarding a contract to IPR Southeast, LLC, in the amount of approximately \$115,693.60. The project scope includes 891 linear feet of corrugated metal pipe cleaning, camera work, repair and concrete relining work on Grand Vista Approach and Chattahoochee Run Drive. Staff recommends piggybacking on the existing City of Dunwoody Contract for this vendor. Previously we have piggybacked on the Gwinnett County Contact, but they have placed a no piggybacking clause in their contract for this type of work. Award of this contract will be included on the January 22, 2019 regular agenda, unless Council prefers otherwise.

3. Resurfacing Projects Update

As of January 2, Allied Paving Company had completed crack sealing work and substantially completed resurfacing work on 9 of the 14 projects.

4. Ordinance to Establish Fees for 2019 Election

The City must adopt an ordinance to call the November 5, 2019 municipal election to fill the expired terms of Mayor and Council posts 1 and 2; and, to establish the qualifying fees.
