I. Twisted Taco Alcohol Beverage License

Twisted Taco, located at 3433 Lawrenceville Suwanee Road, has applied for a new licensee for their alcohol beverage license. Ms. Mikyung Kim has applied as the licensee and the Business Services department recommends approval of the license.

2. RZ-2019-001 - Owners: FGM Organizations Inc. and Vanessa B. Johnson. Applicant: O'Dwyer Properties. The applicant requests a rezoning from GC-A (Gwinnett County Annexed) to R-75 (Single Family Residence District) to allow for detached single-family homes. The site is located on 90 Morning Glen Drive.

L. Consider Award of Contract to Crown Lift Trucks for Public Works Building Project

Staff is presently underway with finalizing quantities and layout of pallet racks and storage areas for the Swiftwater Park Drive Public Works Facility. Staff recommends awarding this contract, contingent on satisfactory completion of contract negotiations, to Crown Lift Trucks in an amount not to exceed \$64,000.

M. Consider Award of Contract to IPR Southeast, LLC for Stormwater Project on Grand Vista Approach and Chattahoochee Run Drive

Staff recommends awarding a contract to IPR Southeast, LLC, in the amount of approximately \$115,693.60. The project scope includes 891 linear feet of corrugated metal pipe cleaning, camera work, repair and concrete relining work on Grand Vista Approach and Chattahoochee Run Drive. Staff recommends piggybacking on the existing City of Dunwoody Contract for this vendor.
