I. Beverage License Application for King Rib Ventures dba Angry Crab Shack, 105 Horizon Drive

This business has applied for a new license for the on-premise consumption of beer, wine & distilled spirits. Ms. Dena Brown and Mr. Gregory Brown have applied to be the licensees and the Business Services department recommends approval.

2. Beverage License Application for First Beverage Suwanee LLC dba Suwanee Topshelf Beverage, 350 Peachtree Industrial Boulevard This business has applied for a new license for the sale of beer, wine & distilled spirits/on premise. Mr. Natwar Patel has applied to be the licensee and the Business Services department recommends approval.

3. 2020 Council Schedule

The recommend priority list submittal to the Georgia Department of Transportation includes 2.95 miles of resurfacing on eleven (11) City streets or portions thereof. This will be included on the <u>November 19th consent agenda</u>, unless Council prefers otherwise.
