Staff received a bid from Newlands Contracting, in the amount of \$72,312.00, to rehabilitate 12,529 square feet of trails at Sims Lake Park. The project includes removing and replacing asphalt trail surfaces that have tree roots and extensive cracking, with improved drainage on trails to give an overall improvement on safe usage.
