A. RZ-2022-001 - Owner: Franklin Property Group LLC and Jennifer Winters Thompson. Applicant: Bruce Rippen, DR Horton

The applicant requests a rezoning from R-100 (Residential Single Family District) to RM-8 (Residential Multi-Family Duplex District) to allow for townhomes. The site is located at the intersection of Suwanee Avenue and Lawrenceville-Suwanee Road and contains approximately 3.06 acres. The Planning Department recommends approval with conditions. This item will be on the <u>February 22nd Council Public Hearing and Regular Agenda</u> unless Council prefers otherwise.

B. Gwinnett County Water and Sewerage Authority Easements

Gwinnett County Water and Sewerage Authority is seeking a Temporary Construction Easement and Permanent Utility Easement for a parcel on the site of the new fire station.

C. GDOT Acquisition of Right-of-Way from City for Martin Farm Road Bridge Reconstruction

GDOT is looking to acquire property owned by the city on both sides of Martine Farm Road to allow for the construction of the Martin Farm Road bridge. Staff has asked them to make revisions to the trail as part of these negotiations. Staff anticipates draft plans from GDOT will be provided by the workshop.
