H. Consider Proposed 4th Quarter FY2022 Capital Funding Transfers
For the 4th quarter of the current budget, staff has proposed capital fund transfers of

\$1,753,700 to pre-fund the capital improvement program (CIP). Pre-funding the capital improvement program allows for pay-as-you-go financing for ongoing capital needs.
