

## **Frequently Asked Questions about the use of Town Center Park:**

### **Q: Can I have my child's birthday party at Town Center Park?**

A: Yes, as long as you follow all of the general guidelines and avoid prohibited activities.

### **Q: Can I use the stage for a performance?**

A: Yes, with no amplified sound and as long as it is not during an event or event set-up.

### **Q. Can I busk in the park?**

A. Busking in city parks is permitted; however, buskers may not interfere with any city-sanctioned event, nor may they be in the Farmers Market area. Under no circumstances may performers impede the use of the park for others. The city reserves the right to ask a performer to relocate within or leave the park at any time. Per regular park policy, no amplified sound or use of park electricity is allowed.

### **Q: Can I host a yoga class or boot camp in the park?**

A: Yes, as long as the general guidelines are met and avoid prohibited activities such as exchange of payment in the park.

### **Q: Can I sell stuff (Girl Scout Cookies, Scout Popcorn, bake sale, etc.) in the park?**

A: No, but you can contact one of the Town Center Merchants to see if they will allow your group to set-up in front of their store for sales.

### **Q: Can I set up a table, cart, or booth in the park to tell people about my business/organization?**

A: No business or organization can set up a booth at the park unless they are part of a scheduled and sanctioned event and have rented space from the event organizer.

### **Q: Can I set up a booth to promote my business at the Farmers Market?**

A: No, all booths at the Suwanee Farmers Market are just for consumable products. The market is not a place for business promotion; however, our events are GREAT for that!

**Q: How do I get a booth at an event?**

A: Check the event schedule at [www.suwanee.com](http://www.suwanee.com) and find out who the planning organization is for each event. Then click on the link to contact them about booths. Some events are organized by the city and there are also many groups who rent the park from the city and organize their own events.

**Q: Can I hold a wedding in a city park?**

A: While we don't take reservations for weddings, you can hold a ceremony in the park but you must follow the general guidelines and avoid prohibited activities. We also can't guarantee that a Frisbee game or kid riding a bike won't happen during the ceremony or your wedding photos!

**Q: Can our church or community group give out water/popsicles/treats at the fountain in the summer?**

A: No. We do not allow groups to distribute products, samples, or free food or drinks of any kind.

**Q: Can our sports team host an end of season party in the park?**

A: Yes, as long as the general guidelines are met and avoid prohibited activities.

**Q: Can we use the stage for an end of the year gathering, event, picnic, etc.?**

A: Yes, as long as the general guidelines are met and avoid prohibited activities.

Scheduled events and event set-up always have first use of the park priority. Check [www.suwanee.com](http://www.suwanee.com) for the most up-to-date information. You may also call city hall to check about event set-up prior to event days.
