A. New Alcohol License – Applicants: Mr. Sanghun Shin and Ms. Jeungah Kim for Yulkkong LLC dba Moo Bong Ri, 3255 Lawrenceville Suite Road, Suite 1-20

Yulkkong LLC dba Moo Bong Ri is a new restaurant that will be opening in May 2024. It will be located at 3255 Lawrenceville Suwanee Rd. Ste 1-20. The owner, Mr. Sanghun Shin, as well as the manager, Ms. Jeungah Kim, have applied to be the licensees for on-premise consumption of beer, wine and distilled spirits. This item will be on the April 23rd Council Public Hearing and Regular Agenda unless Council prefers otherwise.

B. 2024 Local Maintenance Intergovernmental Agreement (LMIG) Road Resurfacing Bid Award to Allied Paving - \$393,275.00

Sealed bids for the 2024 LMIG road resurfacing contract were opened on April 3rd. Staff recommends awarding the bid to Allied Paving in the amount of \$393,275.00. Consideration of this item will appear on the April 23rd Council Regular Agenda unless Council prefers otherwise.

C. Sidewalk Trip Hazard Removal Projects - \$93,955.00

Continuing the city's sidewalk repair projects, subdivisions that are next for repairs are Baxley Point, McGinnis Reserve, Park Pointe, Shadowbrook, and Stonecypher. The city's contracted vendor, Georgia Safe Sidewalks, has submitted a scope of work with an estimated cost of \$93,955.00. Consideration to proceed with this item will be on the April 23rd Council Regular Agenda unless Council prefers otherwise.

D. Art for All "First Look" Event

An invitation-only fundraising event for the Art for All Capital Campaign will be held the evening of Thursday, June 20th with a rain date of June 27th. The event will be held in the new park, Town Center on Main, and will be a "park preview" event and will include food trucks and park tours. See attached for flyer associated with the event.
